Educational Therapy	1-12	ET1 :\$5635 ET2: \$3275	1:1 Therapy sessions offered via NILD (National Institute for Learning Development) HS students receive elective credit.
Search and TEACH	K5	No Charge	One-to-one and small group early childhood intervention 90 minutes per week
SEEK	2-5	\$760	Students <u>E</u> xploring and <u>E</u> nriching for the <u>K</u> ingdom (Gifted Enrichment class taught once a week)
Resource	1-12	\$2185 1 session/week \$3510 2 sessions/week \$4480 3 sessions/week \$5365 4 sessions/week \$6215 5 sessions/week	Individualized support and intervention to reinforce concepts and develop executive functioning skills. Case manager will determine format, pull-out or push-in. Group sessions may be established according to student needs and team agreement. If students are placed in a group model, tuition will be adjusted. HS students will receive elective credit for 5 days of resource.
Tutorial Study Hall	9-12	\$2225	Daily Small Group Study Hall offering assistance in developing executive function skills and monitoring the implementation of classroom accommodations. A maximum of 6 students will be allowed in a class. Students receive an elective credit.
Self-Supported Classroom	K5-4	\$19,500 (tuition included)	Small group self-contained class for students who have intellectual and/or developmental needs.
Case Management	4K-12	\$250	Behind the scenes support to faculty to provide accommodations to students based on individualized needs
Algebra 1- Tech	9 & 10	\$1060 per year for 2 years	Stretching the core concepts of Algebra 1 over a two-year teaching period, this small group class helps students build mathematical competence and confidence. A minimum number of 4 students is needed for this class.
Small Group English I & II	9 & 10	\$1060 per year for 2 years	This small group setting provides students with the necessary adjustments to the typical CP classroom while keeping with the goals, objectives, and content of CP Eng I & II. A minimum number of 4 students is needed for this class.
Learning Lab	9-12	\$3185	This course is a blend of 1-1 tutoring, small group instruction, and individualized computer assignments. This class focuses on preparing, reviewing, and extending upon core academic concepts. This class also emphasizes study skills and executive functioning skills. Requires a minimum of <u>4</u> students for class to be offered.
