CLASS RANK

Students are officially ranked at the end of their sophomore year. Students ranked in the top 6% at the conclusion of their sophomore, junior, or senior year may be eligible for the SC Palmetto Fellows Scholarship based on their cumulative GPA and standardized test scores. For those who qualify, the guidance counselor works directly with these students to ensure that the scholarship is granted.
